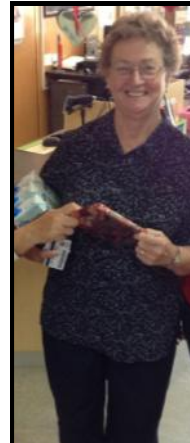
**Community Development Grants** are now open. Ask us how your community group could receive a grant of up to \$4000. Applications close 14th April.

There is a new iPad at the library for catalogue searches. We're happy to show you how to use it if you need help.

You can even search and place holds on library items at home!

Here's how! In easy steps!

### Step 1

go to :<http://www.berribarmeralibrary.org.au>

### Step 2

Click on "Our catalogue" on left hand side



### Step 3

Search for items by author, title or subject

### Step 4

To place items on hold, change your details or renew your loans -

Log on using your borrower number X0.....

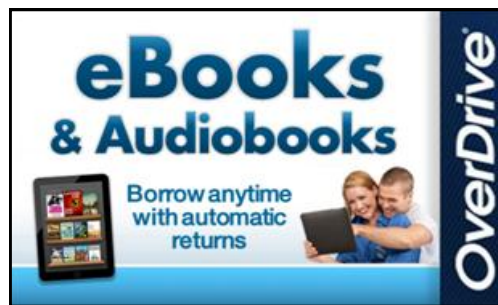
Password is usually your birthdate  
In this 8 digit format yyyymmdd.

Reserve items by clicking on 'Place hold' button. Wait for the email, SMS or phone call to let you know that your items are waiting at Barmera or Berri for you!

You can also extend items if extra time is needed.

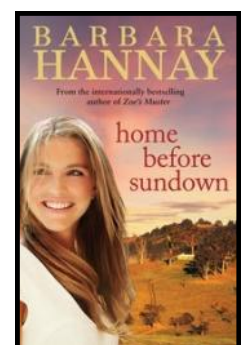
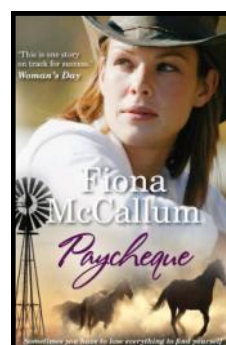
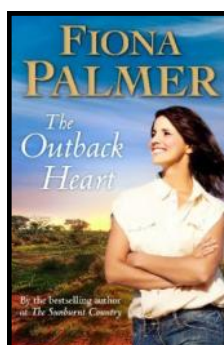
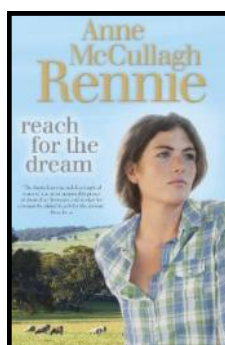
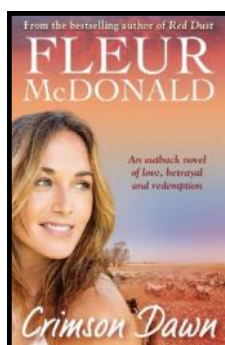
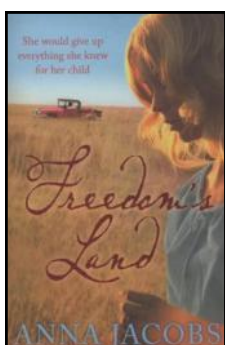
