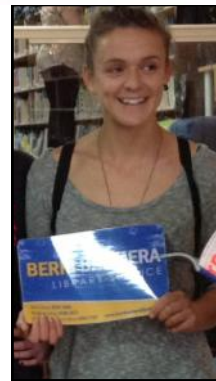
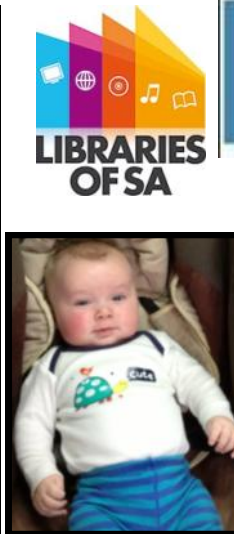

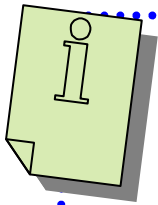

Barmera Library can help!

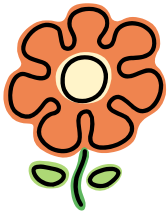
Barmera's newest JP is Library and Council Officer Sue Webber, pictured below with her JP certificate of appointment.
