The good news is that once the shortest day of the year is over (June 21st) then we're on the downhill run towards a sunny springtime! Can't wait!

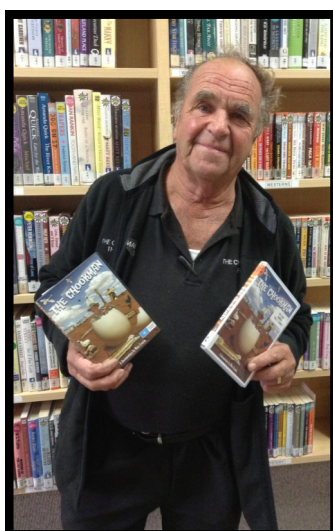
Meanwhile, make the most of the cold weather and curl up with a good book by the fire or heater. Check out our new book and DVD lists in this edition.

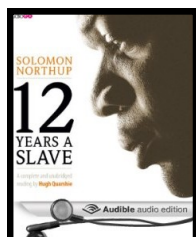
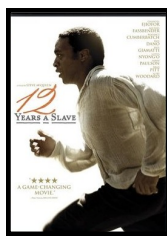
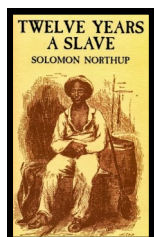
## What's Better? Book or Film?
