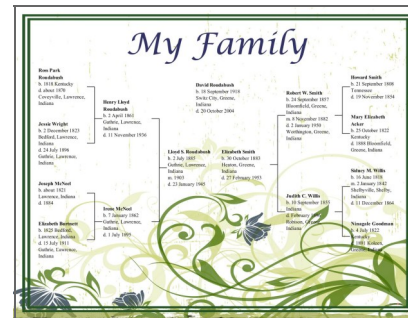


Ancestry

Ancestry Library Edition is only available to access via library computers. Please contact staff to arrange a computer booking for you.

Includes access to Censor and Voter lists, Births, Deaths & Marriages, Military records, Immigration and Emigration files and Newspapers & Periodicals. You can download an ancestral chart or family group sheet to use and also keep research and calendar records as you go.

Check the 'Stories & Publications' and 'Photos & maps' tabs for more details. This is a comprehensive database and will be a huge benefit to Genealogy buffs.

An online encyclopaedia including "Research Tools" with Dictionary, Atlas, Explore Australia, Explore the World, Today in History options. A "Create and Save" section offers My Research, Pathfinders, Citation Builder and Timeline organiser. "In the Headlines" gives updates on news issues and a "Primary Sources" tab offers links to e-books. "Your Most Viewed Articles" will store journal searches and articles for future reference and has email or print options. There are also links to World Book Advanced, World Book Kids and World Book Student

The **Discover** module (accessible from the tabs on the bottom of the home page) offers engaging reference resources including articles, text to speech capabilities, learning & life skills activities, research tools, multimedia & interactive videos. You can create your own account within the database and save your research for future reference.
