Password is usually your birthdate In this 8 digit format yyyymmdd.


Reserve items by clicking on 'Place hold' button. Wait for the email, SMS or phone call to let you know that your items are waiting at Barmera or Berri for you!

You can also extend items if extra time is needed.


All you need to do is go to the Library Catalogue and click on the Overdrive button and a cyber-universe of online material is waiting for you.






