on news issues and a "Primary Sources"
tab offers links to e-books. "Your Most
Viewed Articles" will store journal searches
and articles for future reference and has
email or print options. There are also links
to World Book Advanced, World Book Kids
and World Book Student

The **Discover** module (accessible from the tabs on the bottom of the home page) offers engaging reference resources including articles, text to speech capabilities, learning & life skills activities, research tools, multimedia & interactive videos. You can create your own account within the database and save your research for future reference.
