

FREE INTERNET ACCESS

Both libraries provide FREE Internet bookings on their computers and a WiFi Internet hotspot for customers. Users under 18 years of age must have an Internet Use Agreement form signed by a parent or legal guardian before accessing the Internet for the first time.

If you have a laptop, smartphone or tablet you can access the Internet using the SA Public Library WiFi network. This account can be accessed from any SA public library and usually after hours as well within close range of the building. A library membership number and PIN is required.

• Online Catalogue

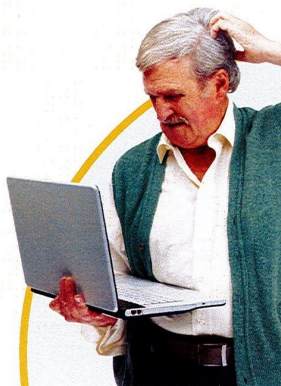

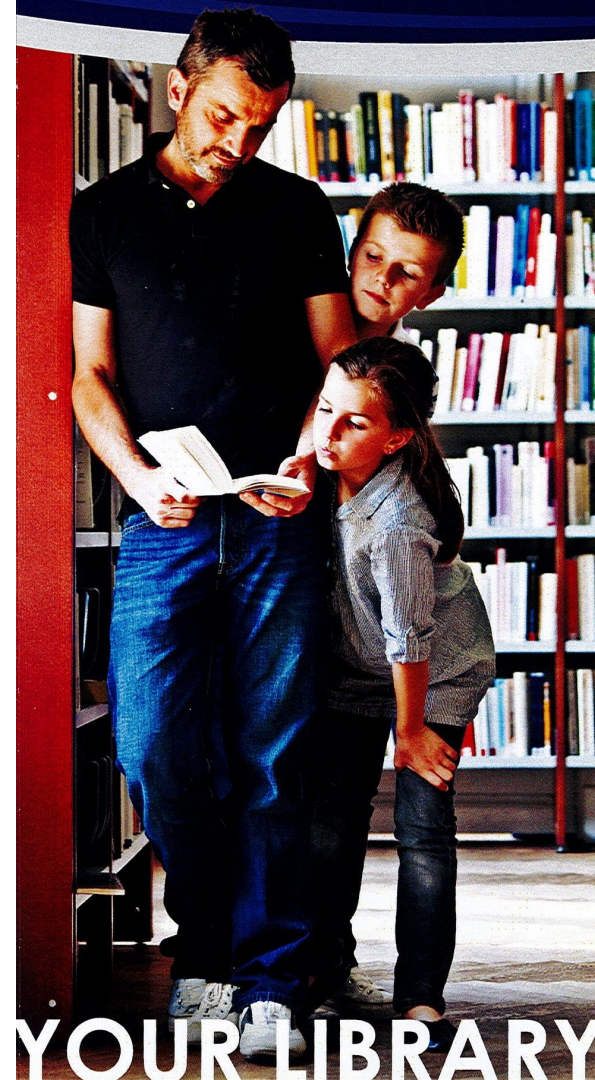

MEMBERSHIP

Membership of the library is free. Proof of identity with a current Driver's Licence or documentation showing your name and current deliverable postal address is required at the time of registration.

A parent or guardian must sign a guarantee for borrowers under 18 years of age.

If you are visiting the area, you can still join the library as a temporary member. ID such as a current passport is required. Limits on borrowing apply.

BORROWING INFORMATION

Residential Borrowers - 100 items at any one time may be borrowed (limits apply to audio-visual resources).

LOAN PERIODS ARE:

4 week loan - Books and audio books

2 week loan - Magazines

2 week loan - DVDs (maximum of 20)

2 week loan - CDs and CD-ROMs (maximum of 20)

2 week loan - E-book reader (maximum 1 reader)

Some smaller collection material is not for loan but we are happy for you to make use of them in the library.

HOLDS

If an item you want is not available, you can search for it across all the One Card libraries using the online catalogue wherever you have Internet access. Alternatively we can search for you – just ask! Once found, you can put a hold on it and select a pickup location, and we will contact you when it arrives.

OVERDUES

Borrowers are responsible for lost or damaged items and if, after an initial overdue reminder notice, items are not returned, an account will be sent.

The Berri Library and Information Centre is a multi-purpose library and information service. It opened for business in January 1999 and has proved a successful amalgamation of services and resources providing a unique and valuable facility for the Riverland. Access to the library car park is via Kay Avenue in Berri.
